Discussed training and experience of Bruce McGibbon, M.D. for 10 CFR 35.300. Amendment request dated September 30, 2013 (Mail Control No. 582333) included NRC Form 313A (AUT) for Dr. McGibbon requested oral administration of I-131 requiring a written directive > 33 mCi and parenteral administration of any beta-emitter, or photon-emitting radionuclide with a photon energy < than 150 keV for which a written directive is required, but did not indicate that they also wanted him to be authorized for oral administration of I-131 requiring a written directive < 33 mCi. Mr. Bohan and I discussed the fact that his Board Certification in Radiation Oncology gets him all of 35.300 and satisfies the classroom training as long as he has the casework, which he submitted casework for 35.394 and 35.396. I explained that the language in 10 CFR 35.392 would allow him to use I-131 < 33 mCi since he is qualified to use I-131 > 33 mCi if they request such authorization. Mr. Bohan stated that they would like Bruce McGibbon, M.D. to be authorized for oral administration of sodium iodide I-131 requiring a written directive in quantities less than or equal to 1.22 gigabecquerels (33 mCi).

Action Required: Amendment to add Bruce McGibbon, M.D. to License No. 06-01060-01 to include authorization for oral administration of sodium iodide I-131 requiring a written directive in quantities less than or equal to 1.22 gigabecquerels (33 mCi).

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
