Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority SmarTrip Benefits for NRC Employees

On December 31, 2013, as a result of a sole source solicitation, a firm-fixed-price contract (NRC-HQ-40-14-C-0002) was awarded to the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA) of Washington, DC. This contract will provide the NRC with transit fare to distribute to NRC employees that use public transit and other surrounding transit systems affiliated with WMATA from home to work through SmarTrip cards. The period of performance is January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014, with four 1-year option periods. The total estimated ceiling is \$6,300,000.00, inclusive of all options.
