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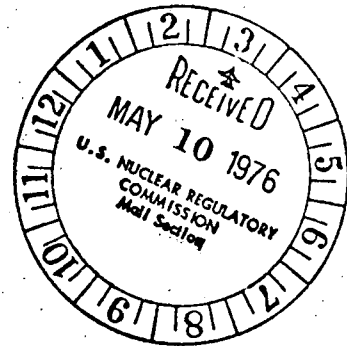
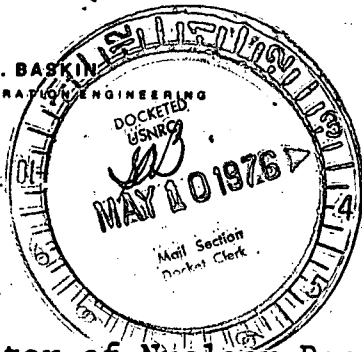

By letter dated April 12, 1976, additional information in response to the Commission's letter dated March 31, 1976, was submitted to the Regulatory Staff and served on all parties to the San Onofre Units 2 and 3 construction permit proceedings.
