



JANUARY 13, 2014

On Monday, January 13, 2014, Mr. William Sharp, Principal Attorney, New York State Department of State (NYSDOS) contacted Ms. Michelle Moser, Environmental Scientist, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) via telephone. Mr. Sharp stated that NYSDOS received the letter from NRC, dated December 6, 2013. This letter contained six questions seeking clarification regarding the coastal zone consistency review process for New York State in regards to the license renewal of Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit Nos. 2 and 3 (Agency Document Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML13281A065). Mr. Sharp stated that NYSDOS sent NRC an initial response to confirm that NYSDOS received NRC's letter. In addition, NYSDOS will be sending NRC a follow up letter that will address the six questions posed by the NRC.
