This letter responds to condition 23 in license number SUC-1593 (Docket 040-9083), which says, "The licensee shall provide a plant sampling plan to the NRC within 90 days of [October 23, 2013] for review and approval." The required plant sampling plan is enclosed.

For your information, we performed plant sampling in accordance with this plan in June 2013. The final report for that sampling was not ready before you issued the license, but it is near completion now. We will send that report to you as soon as we receive it from the contractor in final form.
