Subject: Summary of Most Recent B&W mPower Inc. (B&W) Inspection of the New SGI Facility and Program Infrastructure at Bechtel Power Corporation (BPC)

Reference : B&W Letter No. MPWR-LTR-13-00048: "Summary of Recent B&W mPower Inc. Inspection of the relocated SGI Facility and Program Infrastructure at Bechtel Power Corporation (BPC) dated August 14, 2013

In the above referenced letter dated August 14, 2013, B&W informed the NRC that our security staff had completed an inspection of the SGI storage and control facility at the BPC facility in Frederick, MD. This location of SGI was established in accordance of the B&W SGI Plan Addendum approved by the NRC in March 2013. Subsequent to that August inspection, BPC initiated a plan to relocate their offices and the SGI facility to another building on the BPC campus. Based on this plan, B&W did not ship SGI to the inspected SGI facility.

This subsequent relocation of the BPC SGI facility has been completed. In accordance with our SGI Plan, our security staff completed an inspection of the relocated BPC SGI storage and control facility on December 5, 2013. That inspection was conducted using NRC's inspection procedure, "IP 71130.06, Protection of Safeguards Information," dated January 7, 2010. The inspection addressed the applicable inspection criteria, and included an evaluation of procedures. A review of BPC's controlled access area (CAA) was also performed where all equipment, storage cabinets, and the room itself were inspected for compliance with the approved B&W SGI Plan Addendum. The scope of the inspection included the following: SGI protection system (policy and procedures), access to SGI, protection of SGI, marking of SGI, processing, reproducing and transmitting SGI, removal of information from SGI category, and destruction of SGI.

Based upon this inspection, BPC's implementation of the SGI Protection Plan Addendum, and BPC's corporate and mPower project specific safeguards information procedures, B&W has concluded that BPC meets the requirements set forth in the applicable NRC regulations and is compliant with the B&W SGI Plan Addendum for the protection and control of SGI.

Therefore, we are resuming storage and control of SGI at the current BPC facility discussed above.
