There is no need to notify us, and me in particular, when you simply return gauges to the vendor. Lots of our licensees do that every day and we do not track this information in the Regional office. We do not amend your license for this reason unless you specifically direct us to permanently take authorization for these gauges off of your license. You would have to submit an amendment request to do that and additional information, beyond what you have provided here, would be required to do that.

If your gauges are in the Nationally Tracked Sources or Generally Licensed Tracking System, you may need to update those databases with the appropriate persons in our headquarters offices.

Unless previously arranged with me directly, licensees should not submit notifications or amendment requests, renewal requests, licensing correspondence, etc. to me directly. My supervisor directs my work.

At this time, I will not be doing anything with the information you have enclosed, as it does not appear that you are requesting a licensing action at this time.
