**SUMMARY**

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) contacted Private Fuel Storage (PFS) to discuss documentation supporting their 2014 annual fee exemption request (ML13304A525). PFS was informed that the documentation dated January 6, 2014 (ML14043A299) was insufficient because it did not identify the actions PFS had taken to make use of their Part 72 license. PFS explained that two steps were necessary to utilize the license, and although they were listed as co-litigants on court documents, they were not actively involved in both steps. According to PFS, the first step required the Bureau of Indian affairs approve Goshute tribal land being leased to PFS. The second step required PFS negotiate with the Department of the Interior for the land rights to construct a rail spur to the Goshute tribal land. PFS further explained that, in their opinion, it was unnecessary to negotiate for land rights to construct a rail spur until discussions about leasing tribal land had been concluded. The NRC thanked PFS for this explanation as these facts were not readily apparent from the court documents, but maintained that, according to their previous annual fee exemption (ML13270A280), documentation must be provided which showed the actions PFS had performed to utilize their license.

With this understanding, PFS committed to search for additional documentation. The call was concluded at approximately 11:15 A.M. Eastern Standard Time.
