A meeting was held in July of 2013 in Kyle, SD that was attended by Commissioner Bill Magwood (NRC Commission), Mark Sartorious and 2 other NRC staff members. The Tribal THPO's for Oglala Sioux Tribe and the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe were present. Commissioner Magwood was informed of the incomplete and disastrous Section 106 identification efforts for the Dewey Burdock project. Commissioner Magwood assured the tribes at this meeting that there would be a future opportunity to possibly revisit the site or set up another meeting to address these concerns. This meeting is absent from the timeline included in this PA. The SRST-THPO sent an email to Haimanot Yilma concerning the incomplete Section 106 identification effort on September 16, 2013 and referenced Commissioner Magwood and his concerns. There was no response to SRST-THPO inquiries.

For your information, I have attached emails I sent to you and Ms. Young in response to your questions regarding an additional opportunity for a site visit of the Dewey Burdock project.
