Discussion: (10:15) I left a message on Dr. Tongson's voice-mail to return my call. (13:05) I spoke with Ms. Pease about the license and its pending expiration date. She stated that the physics Department was moving to a new building, that another dean would be taking over for her, and that school vacation and the snow probably was occupying their thoughts. She agreed to send an e-mail to the people involved reminding them of the pending expiration of the license and, if allowed to expire, the application would be treated as a new license application rather than a renewal which would cost the university fees. (14:10) Dr. Tongson returned my call. I stated that I had been in contact with Ms. Pease and repeated why I was contacting the licensee. Dr. Tongson requested where he might obtain the required forms and what would be needed for the application. I explained where to find NRC Form 313 and the basic information needed for a storage and possession only license. If it was decided that he would use the sources, then he would need to amend the license. If additional information was needed a license reviewer would contact him but the license would be considered "Deemed Timely" only if the application was received prior to February 28th. I provided the fax number of the Region I office for his convenience.
