Subject: Status of DFP

Discussion: (2/20/14; 15:00) I left messages for Mr. Brown and Mr. Banks requesting an update on the status of the DFP. (16:16) Mr. Brown returned my call and left a message on my voice-mail. He stated that he has completed the historical review of the DFP. There was one building where tritium was used in the laboratories. A survey had been performed releasing the building for unrestricted use. The building is in the final stages of demolition and removal of debris. The only remaining items to be considered for the DFP are the Krypton-85 device and depleted uranium powders. Mr. Brown indicated that he would call me on the 21<sup>st</sup> to talk over the DFP in more detail. (16:17) Mr. Banks returned my call and left a voice-mail message. He stated that the licensee's response to our request for information was in process. Due to the number of weather events, the work on the DFP has been delayed. I was welcome to call him and talk about the matter.

(2/21/14; 13:05) I contacted Mr. Brown to obtain more information about the historical review. Mr. Brown indicated that the last use of material was in 2002 and that the previous RSO had performed a survey to show that the building could be released. During an inspection, Mr. Brown stated that the survey from 2002 could not be found. The inspector indicated that another survey would need to be performed. Mr. Brown stated he performed the survey in 2007 prior to turning the building over to Department of the Army. The building is almost completely demolished. Mr. Brown indicated that he has never submitted the survey to the NRC for free release of the facility. I stated that I would review the docket and ADAMS to see if a request was ever made to release the facility. Required information for release of the facility was in the document at ADAMS Accession No. ML072851139 dated October 10, 2007, and approved on October 19, 2007.
