SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MARCH 4, 2014, PUBLIC MEETING TO DISCUSS  
GUIDANCE DEVELOPMENT FOR PERIODIC TRAINING AND DRILLS,  
EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES  
RELATED TO ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH NEAR-TERM TASK  
FORCE RECOMMENDATIONS 4, 8, AND 9.3

On March 4, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 3 public meeting with the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI), industry representatives, and other interested stakeholders. (The meeting notice is available via the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) under Accession No. ML14049A001.) The purpose of the meeting was to discuss paths forward for addressing the recommendations in the *Near-Term Task Force (NTTF) Recommendations for Enhancing Reactor Safety in the 21st Century* report, issued July 12, 2011 (ADAMS Accession No. ML111861807). A meeting attendance list is included as an Enclosure to this summary. The meeting was focused on two main topical areas: 1) Conceptual construct on consolidated rulemaking for NTTF recommendations 4, 8, and 9.3; and 2) two draft NEI-developed guidance documents, "NEI 13-06: Enhancements to Emergency Response Capabilities for Beyond Design Basis Accidents and Events" and "NEI 14-01: Emergency Response Procedures and Guidelines for Extreme Events and Severe Accidents" (ADAMS Accession Nos. ML14049A002 and ML14049A005, respectively). Public participation was invited via meeting attendance, telephone conference and Web-based seminar ("webinar").

During the first portion of the public meeting, the NRC staff used a webinar format to present the conceptual construct of a consolidated rulemaking for NTTF Recommendations 4, 8, 9.3. The construct also includes Recommendations 7, 9.1, 9.2, 9.4, 10.2 and 11.1. This conceptual construct document was made publicly available on February 28, 2014 (ADAMS Accession No. ML14052A057), under docket numbers NRC-2011-0299 and NRC-2012-0031 on [www.regulations.gov](http://www.regulations.gov), and the NRC slides are available in ADAMS under Accession No. ML14065A265. Although no comments were collected at this time, the NRC, industry and other stakeholders briefly discussed the conceptual construct and the proposed path forward for rulemaking. At this public meeting, the NRC staff agreed to hold public meetings in the future specifically focused on the draft regulatory analysis as well as draft guidance documents during the proposed rule phase.

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In the second part of this meeting, the NRC staff discussed their collective comments on NEI 13-06 and NEI 14-01 from the working group. NEI stated that they understood the NRC staff's comments and would meet with their respective working groups and Fukushima Response Steering Committee to review and revise the NEI 13-06 and NEI 14-01 guidance documents, as appropriate. The staff suggested that future meetings are needed in the upcoming months to finalize NEI 13-06 and NEI 14-01 and would coordinate with NEI on scheduling the next meeting.

Members of the public participated in the webinar and asked clarifying questions throughout the meeting.
