This letter is to inform you that we have completed our review of your Characterization Survey Plan, dated February 2014 (ADAMS Accession Number ML14058A373) and the information provided in your letters, dated August 14, 2013 (ML13232A289) and December 23, 2013 (ML14014A080). We have informed the State of Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) on the results of our review. Based on our review, the NRC has no further questions and we expect that you will continue with your activities at the site.

In addition, you should review your Final Status Survey Plan (FSSP) to determine if any changes are required as a result of the characterization survey activities. We request that you submit any changes made to your FSSP for NRC review prior to implementation.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011.
