

Instructions for Remote Participation in the Public Meeting to Discuss Fuel Fragmentation, Relocation and Dispersal Research Plan and Regulatory Resolution Strategy on March 13-14, 2014.

The following information is provided to explain the process for remote participation in this public meeting.

For this meeting, the slides will be shown through GoToMeeting and the audio will be available through a conference call-in line. There is a separate link for Thursday and Friday's webinar, but the bridge line will be the same.

You should register for the webinar before the meeting using the links below:

After registering, you will receive an email with a unique link for you to use to log on the day of the meeting.

On the day of the meeting, you will click on the link you received by email. This will allow you to see all the slides being presented in real time. When you use this link, we will see the name registered for this link appear on the virtual attendees list and any questions asked once logged on will be associated with this name, that's why the email indicates that the link shouldn't be shared with others. Also, keep in mind that there is a separate link for each day.

You can hear the audio from the meeting by calling into a bridge line. The call in number will be the same for both days. There is a toll free call-in number for those calling from within the US, and a toll number for those calling from outside the US. The numbers are:

In both cases, the pass code will be 1879546.

This line will be run by an operator who will work with callers who would like to make a comment or actively join discussions. This will only occur at designated points throughout the agenda.
