## **SUMMARY**

By letter dated January 27, 2014, AREVA Inc., (AREVA) requested an amendment to Certificate of Compliance No. 9217, for the Model No. ANF-250 transportation package. The letter requested name changes on certain certificates of compliance due to corporate reorganization at AREVA Inc. The certificate has been updated to Revision No. 17 to reflect the changes.

## **EVALUATION**

The purpose of the amendment was to change the name of the entity the certificate of compliance is issued to from "Transnuclear, Inc." to the new name "AREVA Inc." AREVA also submitted a description of its Quality Assurance Program Description Manual, Revision No. 13, for which Quality Assurance Program Approval for Radioactive Material Packages No. 0250, Revision No. 20, is being issued by NRC. Certificate of Compliance No. 9217, Revision No. 17, is being issued under this Quality Assurance Program Approval.

These changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.

## CONDITIONS

The following changes have been made to the certificate of compliance:

Section 3.a. of the certificate of compliance has been revised to reflect the new name of the certificate holder, "AREVA Inc." as requested.

The previous Condition No. 8 was deleted, as it expired in June 2010. The new Condition No. 8 reflects the previous Condition No.10, prohibiting transport of fissile material by air.

The previous Condition No. 9 was deleted, as it expired in July 2011. The new Condition No. 9 allows use of the previous certificate revision until March 31, 2015.

The new Condition No. 10 reflects the previous Condition No. 11, the certificate expiration date of June 30, 2015.

The References section has been updated to include the name change request.

# CONCLUSION

Based on the statements and representations in the amendment request, the staff finds that these changes do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
