This is in reference to Condition 29 of NRC License Number 19-00915-03 and the decommissioning plan for the low-level radioactive waste burial site in Beltsville, Maryland. As you know, we have reviewed field conditions at the site and determined that modifying some of the procedures described in the decommissioning plan would improve worker safety, increase containment of the buried radioactive material during excavation of other, near-by materials, and provide more robust sampling of soils that are not anticipated to be contaminated and can be returned to the site after excavation. The contractor approved to implement the decommissioning plan, TES, Inc., will follow NRC guidance in NUREG 1757, Chapter 18 - Decommissioning Plans: Modifications to Decommissioning Programs and Procedures, which is the process for modifying decommissioning plan procedures without prior NRC approval (see enclosed letter from D. Caputo, TES, Inc. dated July 3.)
