

Subject: Transfer of Sealed Source and Device Registration Certificate (AZ-05010D-108-B) for Honeywell Model 4203 from Arizona to Georgia and add tungsten alloy as an additional material of construction to the certificate.

Dear Mr. Jameson:

This letter is our request to transfer the Sealed Source and Device Registration Certificate from Arizona to Georgia. Currently Honeywell devices are no longer manufactured or distributed in the State of Arizona. Manufacturing operations are still conducted in Waterford, Ireland and in North Vancouver, Canada. In the United States distribution of Honeywell devices is only from our facility in Duluth, Georgia.

To make Honeywell devices consistent with the policies of the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission we are requesting that the Georgia Department of Resources transfer the SS&D certificate for the Honeywell Model 4203 Thickness Gauge, from Arizona to Georgia. We have been distributing the Model 4203 device since 1999, in the United States and World wide without any significant incidents that threatened the health and safety of personnel, property or the environment.

In addition to transferring the SS&D certificate we would also like to add an additional material of construction for the model 4203 series of devices. There will be no change in the operation and it will be exactly the same as the Model 4203 currently being distributed but devices in the 4203 series will be constructed of stainless steel or tungsten alloy. The devices made of Tungsten will provide greater radiation shielding properties and the dose rate profiles will be lower than the profiles for devices constructed with stainless steel. Devices constructed with tungsten alloy will provide additional shielding and will be used when decreased radiation profiles are required.

To assist you in the transfer I have included a complete file containing all documents submitted to both California and Arizona.
