Attached please find a letter from US Ecology, Inc. formally requesting withdrawal of our Request for Exemptions for the Studsvik Processing Facility project in Memphis, TN, submitted to NRC on June 14, 2013. We are no longer pursuing a business arrangement with Studsvik and therefore do not require approval of this project from NRC. NRC review was being performed under Docket #04038368.
