The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has completed the environmental review for a Source and Byproduct Materials License application submitted by Strata Energy, Inc., for the construction, operation, aquifer restoration, and decommissioning of the proposed Ross In Situ Uranium Recovery (ISR) Project (Ross Project). The facility is proposed to be located in Crook County, Wyoming.

NRC staff issued the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) for public comment in March 2013. Comments received on the Draft SEIS have been addressed in Appendix B of this Final SEIS (NUREG-1910, Supplement 5). The Final SEIS includes an analysis of relevant environmental issues and documents the NRC staff's final determination regarding the environmental impacts from the construction, operation, aquifer restoration, and decommissioning of the proposed in situ uranium recovery site. It states that, unless safety issues mandate otherwise, a Source and Byproduct Materials License for the Proposed Action be issued as requested.

The Final SEIS is now available through the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) (<http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>) at accession number ML14056A096.
