Pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (16 U.S.C. § 470f) and 36 C.F.R. Part 800, the staff of the Indiana State Historic Preservation Officer ("Indiana SHPO") has conducted an analysis of the materials received on February 10, 2014, for the above indicated area in Jefferson County, Indiana.

It is our understanding that the proposed submission is in regard to the termination of the Army's license under restricted release in the Depleted Uranium Impact Area and that no demolition, construction, or ground disturbing activities are proposed in regard to this submission. We have no additional comments.

Our office looks forward to assisting Jefferson Proving Grounds with any future reviews. It is our understanding that the management of the property in regard to cultural resources will follow the property's ICRMP (2011).
