RE: REPLY TO VIOLATION ON NRC INSPECTION REPOPRT NO. 03038598/2014001

A notice of violation dated 11 February 2014 was received on the mail on February 25. The violation indicates that the licensed material was transported outside the usage site on public highway and the driver of the vehicle did not ensure that the shipping papers were readily available in the driver's compartment as required.

The licensed material was at the storage location and actually is not in use. At that time it was moved to the office of Mr. David Rhoe for the 6 month's leak test and the driver carried with him all the papers regarding the gage. However the shipping paper was included with it but was not filled up according to the regulation.

After the inspection immediate action was taken in order to correct this situation and avoid it in future. All necessary papers were revised and are ready for their proper use next time the gage has to be moved from the storage location. This is the first time we have licensed material and we are taking all necessary actions to avoid future violations. This will include refreshing courses for the person involved in the use of the material and others that may be in the area of use when the equipment will be at any particular project.
