On March 28, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your Watts Bar Nuclear Plant. The inspection covered one or more of the key attributes of the security cornerstone of the NRC's Reactor Oversight Process. Portions of the inspection associated with Access Authorization, Protection of Safeguards Information, and Fitness for Duty were completed at the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) Corporate Office on February 14, 2014. The enclosed Inspection Report documents the inspection results that were discussed on March 28, 2014, with Mr. C. Church and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed activities, and interviewed personnel.

No findings were identified during this inspection.
