

SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF APRIL 9, 2014, PUBLIC TELECONFERENCE
REGARDING POTENTIAL SUBMISSION OF A LICENSE
AMENDMENT REQUEST TO IMPLEMENT TSTF-477 FOR
CONTROL ROOM AIR CONDITIONING SUBSYSTEMS

On April 9, 2014, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a public teleconference¹ with the Duke Energy Carolinas (Duke). The purpose of the meeting was to discuss Duke's intent to submit a license amendment request to implement TSTF-477 for the McGuire Nuclear Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2.

Duke presented a write-up² that described the background and decision rationale for wanting to implement the TSTF. Subsequently, the NRC staff asked questions and provided feedback to Duke. The following points were taken from the discussion:

- TSTF-477 was originally developed for Boiling Water Reactor control rooms and as such, the licensee would need to fully justify its applicability to a Pressurized Water Reactor control room.
- The projected submittal date for the amendment request is spring/summer 2014 with a requested review time of 1 year.
- The amendment request should include a summary of the operational history for the affected systems.
