Order

(Granting the Parties' Requested Extension of Time)

On April 11, 2014, the Board in this proceeding issued an order instructing the NRC Staff and Shaw AREVA MOX Services, LLC (Applicant) to reply to Intervenors' comments on the redactions to LBP-14-01 that have been proposed by the Staff, Applicant, and NRC's Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response.¹ The Board asked the parties to file their replies by April 16, 2014, to include both an indication of which entity proposed each redaction and a proposal for how the Board should proceed with the redaction process in order to expedite public release of LBP-14-01.² The Board's order anticipated the possibility that the parties might need an extension of time to prepare their replies.³

On April 14, 2014, the Staff filed an unopposed motion to extend the time for response to the Board's order until May 2, 2014.⁴ In support of its motion, the Staff stated that (1) response "will require coordination by multiple entities and agencies," (2) the Staff and Applicant "are concurrently developing Answers to Intervenors' March 27, 2014 Petition for Review of LBP-14-01," and (3) the Staff has garnered support from both Applicant and Intervenors for the requested extension.⁵ The Staff also indicated that Applicant has joined in its request for a time extension.⁶

In light of the foregoing, the Staff and Applicant's request for an extension of time until May 2, 2014 to respond to the Board's order is GRANTED.

It is so ORDERED.
