General Comment

Do not exempt Nuclear Plant owners from off-site Emergency Planning from Reactors which are being decommissioned but still have toxic materials on site.

In the case of Vermont Yankee, the recent approval of the license to operate the plant until the end of 2014 included evidence concerning the unreliability of the owners to be responsible in their actions regarding safety at the Plant. They have had a record of lying to the government and the public.

In other words, can they be trusted to safely move waste to dry cask storage safely without endangering the surrounding areas, people and property?

Without exemption, there is a better chance of the public being aware of what's going on with the decommissioning, and that it is being done safely.
