SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF APRIL 7 PUBLIC MEETING WITH THE DEPARTMENT
OF ENERGY TO DISCUSS REVISION OF THE TECHNICAL REPORT
ON POSTCLOSURE GROUNDWATER IMPACTS FOR A GEOLOGIC
REPOSITORY FOR DISPOSAL OF SPENT NUCLEAR FUEL AND
HIGH-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE AT YUCCA MOUNTAIN

On Monday, April 7, 2014, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff from the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) held a Category 1 public meeting at NRC headquarters in Rockville, Maryland, with staff from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE). The purpose of the meeting was for DOE to discuss its plans, the content, and the schedule for providing to NRC the revised report, "Analysis of Postclosure Groundwater Impacts for a Geologic Repository for the Disposal of Spent Nuclear Fuel and High-Level Radioactive Waste at Yucca Mountain, Nye County, Nevada." The facilitated meeting began at 1:30 p.m. EST and concluded at approximately 2:30 p.m. EST.

NRC staff began the meeting with some brief opening remarks, followed by a presentation from DOE. In the presentation DOE indicated that it will issue a new edition of the existing report, and that this revised report could be sent to the NRC as soon as the end of April, 2014. DOE concluded upon consideration of all new information that has been reviewed since the 2009 report, that no material physical changes have happened at the site, nothing has been learned that would invalidate any of the numerical models that were used, the input data used in the

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numerical modeling are still conservative, and the conclusions from the 2009 report will have no significant differences from the 2014 report.

At the conclusion of DOE's presentation, NRC staff provided questions and comments regarding differences between the 2009 and 2014 reports, followed by a public comment period. There were 87 participants in the public meeting, including members of the public, state and Federal governments, industry, public advocacy and environmental interest groups, and the NRC. The enclosure provides a list of those who participated in the meeting either in person or via bridgeline.
