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### North Anna Technical Specification Bases (Rev 6) Editorial Comments

During the review, the NRC staff noted minor comments in the Technical Specifications Bases within the July 2013 submission (Revision 6). These comments are editorial in nature and are items that are not in accordance with the Writer's Guide For Plant-Specific Improved Technical Specifications (TSTF-GG-05-01). The applicant should make the corrections and perform a global check of the Technical Specifications and Bases (Chapters 16 and 16B respectively) to ensure that all requirements are met prior to the next revision submission.

#### • Section B 3.3.3.2

 All 5 pages for this section have incomplete page numbers at the bottom of the pages. The pages are marked "-1", "-2", etc. vice "B3.3.3.2-1", "B3.3.3.2-2", etc. in accordance with TSTF-GG-05-01, Section 2.1.2.f.

## Page B 3.3.6.3-19

 No single line running along the bottom of the page in accordance with TSTF-GG-05-01, Section 2.1.6 "Double and Single Line Format".

#### Page B 3.10.4-5

- References section labeled "REFERENCE" vice "REFERENCES" in accordance with TSTF-GG-05-01, Section 4.2.1.g, which states that the subsection is titled "References".
- TSTF-GG-05-01, Section 2.4.2.e.2, discusses when a section or specification is continued from one page to the next. When text is continued, the next page has the following requirements: "The continued Section or Specification header is repeated one blank line below the single line at the top of the continued page. The "(continued)" appears immediately below the Section or Specification heading indented two spaces from the left margin." The following pages need to address this requirement:
  - o Page B 3.7.6-3
    - First section should be marked "LCO (continued)".
  - o Page B 3.3.1.4-21
    - Section should be marked "REFERENCES (continued)".
  - o Page B 3.3.6.3-16
    - First section should be marked "APPLICABLE SAFETY ANALYSIS, LCO, and APPLICABILITY (continued)".
  - o Page B 3.6.1.5-2
    - First section incorrectly marked "CONTAINMENT SAFETY ANALYSIS (contained)" vice "APPLICABLE SAFETY ANALYSIS (continued)".
  - o Page B 3.7.6-3
    - First section should be marked "LCO (continued)".
