Dear Mrs. Cuthbert (ACE),

I am writing in response to your April 4, 7, and 8, 2014, emails (ML14097A385) that requested that we provide copies of the first quarter 2014 integrated inspection report and the 2013 Limerick Generating Station (LGS) annual effluents report in advance of the May 7, 2014, Limerick Annual Assessment Meeting. The LGS Technical Specifications and Off-Site Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM), require that the Annual Radioactive Effluent Release Report covering the operation of the units during the previous year shall be submitted prior to May 1 of each year in accordance with 10 CFR 50.36a. Therefore, the LGS 2013 report is due to be submitted by Exelon to the NRC by May 1, 2014. Once the NRC makes the effluent report publically available, we will inform you. Regarding the first quarter 2014 integrated inspection report, we are aware of your request and will inform you as soon as it becomes publically available.

We still want to know why NRC would allow Exelon to wait over three months to submit its Radiological Report for Limerick, especially when NRC is holding a public meeting on Limerick's 2013 operations May 7.

Based on my understanding of your request, I believe that the information that you seek is in the annual Radioactive Effluents Release Report that Exelon submits for Limerick in accordance with Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 50.36a (a)(2). To the best of my knowledge, Exelon has not submitted the 2013 report for Limerick. Mr. Bower,

Your response suggests you are refusing to provide ample time for public review and discussion of Limerick's 2013 Radiological Releases at Limerick's May 7 Annual Meeting.

Your meeting is on Limerick's 2013 operations. Over 3 months after 2013 ended, NRC should have Exelon's report available for public review with at least 30 days prior to the

meeting. But, this appears to be a typical NRC tactic to avoid transparency, public scrutiny and discussion.

Why would you schedule a Limerick meeting to discuss 2013 operations, and withhold important health-related relevant information?

Mr. Bower,

You stated, "The most recent inspection in this area was conducted in February 2014 and will be included in the first quarter 2014 integrated inspection report that will be issued on or about May 15, 2014."

You planned Limerick's annual meeting for May 7, 2014. We request that the most recent inspection report for the February, 2014 inspection be completed and e-mailed to ACE at least several days prior to the 5-7-14 meeting.

We also noticed that the Radiological Effluent Report for 2013 is not available for the public to discuss at the 5-7-14 annual meeting on 2013 findings at Limerick. It is now April 4, 2014. Limerick's Radiological Effluent Reports have typically been over 100

pages. To give ample time for meaningful public review and comments, the 2013 report for the annual meeting should be posted very SOON. We should have at least 30 days for review.

PLEASE SEND US A DIRECT LINK TO THE 2013 RADIOLOGICAL REPORT FOR LIMERICK AND THE FEBRUARY INSPECTION REPORT, AS SOON AS THEY ARE POSTED.
