RE: Identification of Responsible Individuals for Detroit Water & Sewerage Department

The Detroit Water & Sewerage Department has been identified as a General Licensee (Recipient Code: 712575) by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (“NRC”) and is in receipt of the Notice filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Michigan Southern Division (Docket #0227, Filed 07/31/2013) for the City of Detroit. As a general licensee, we are required to comply with the regulations at 10 CFR Part 31.5 *et seq.*

During our meeting and your inspection of January 14, 2014, you confirmed that certain devices identified in NRC records exist and have required us to identify and designate a “Responsible Individual” in accordance with 10 CFR 31.5 (c)(12):

(12) Shall appoint an individual responsible for having knowledge of the appropriate regulations and requirements and the authority for taking required actions to comply with appropriate regulations and requirements. The general licensee, through this individual, shall ensure the day-to-day compliance with appropriate regulations and requirements. This appointment does not relieve the general licensee of any of its responsibility in this regard.

Therefore, we nominate the following two (2) persons as the Responsible Individuals for the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department:

We also wish to note that NRC records had previously identified 1331 Lyndon, Detroit, MI as a Detroit Water and Sewerage Department location. The location does not belong to the Detroit Water and Sewerage Department, but is part of the Homeland Security group for the City. It is my understanding that Homeland Security has provided you with notice for that location under separate cover.

We are in the process of verifying the inventory of devices and will determine subsequent actions that will be taken, including disposal through an appropriately designated party.
