By letter dated October 18, 2013, (Agencywide Document Access and Management System Accession No. ML13295A006) FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company submitted a license amendment request for Beaver Valley Power Station Units 1 and 2 (BVPS). The proposed amendment would modify the BVPS Technical Specifications by relocating specific surveillance frequencies to a licensee controlled program with the implementation of Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) 04-10, "Risk-Informed Technical Specifications Initiative 5b, Risk-Informed Method for Control of Surveillance Frequencies."
