Per our telephone conversation of April 24, 2014, along with subsequent e-mail correspondence, a request was made to change the Authorized Use of the Cs-137 sealed Amersham Model 773 calibration source utilized at this location of use, to more adequately define the scope of use and practice.

The current license condition states:

Authorized Use (9G): "For use in an Amersham Model 773 calibration device for calibration of instruments, including commercial calibration service for any person as defined in 10CFR30, Section 30.4."

Please change the existing license condition to the following statement:

Authorized Use (9G): "For use in an Amersham Model 773 calibration device for calibration of instruments used at facilities covered by this license."

St. Vincent supports this amendment request which allows Edward E. Wroblewski, MA, d/b/a *Photon Measurements Plus* to utilize this source at this location for commercial use.

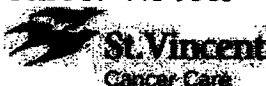
