2. With this information, assuming it is the same information SCE gave to Areva? I would like to have Marvin Resinkoff run the numbers to do the cooling and heat load calculations. To do that accurately we will need each assembly ID, burnup, uranium enrichment, date moved to the pools, whether fuel is damaged, and cladding material. (if you won't share the DOE report you could give us the same info you gave Areva to do their cooling calculations)

It is clear now that SCE will use the 32 cask system now that the notification by NRC on May 1 was released that the 32 dry cask has been approved on April 18 or 23. Quite the coincidence that the NRC announcement about this happened the day before our event.
