**SUBJECT: LIMITED SENIOR REACTOR OPERATOR REQUALIFICATION PROGRAM
INSPECTION FOR LIMERICK GENERATING STATION AND PEACH BOTTOM
ATOMIC POWER STATION**

Dear Mr. Pacilio:

In a telephone conversation on May 12, 2014, Mr. Peter Presby, Senior Operations Engineer, Region I, and Mr. Dave Molteni, Operations Training Manager, Limerick Generating Station, made arrangements for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to inspect the dual limited senior reactor operator requalification program for the Limerick and Peach Bottom facilities. The inspection is planned for the week of June 2, 2014, which coincides with your regularly scheduled requalification examination cycle. The staff at your Limerick facility should prepare and conduct the requalification examinations in accordance with your NRC-approved requalification program.

In accordance with Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 55.59(c), the NRC may request facility licensees to submit their biennial comprehensive requalification written examinations or annual operating tests as necessary to support the NRC's inspection program needs. In order for the NRC to adequately prepare for this inspection, please furnish: 1) an index or summary of condition reports written in the past 2 years in which licensed operator errors were determined to be the root or contributing cause; 2) copies of all procedures related to program administration; and 3) the examination schedule, sample plan, written examinations, and operating test scheduled for the week of the inspection, to the NRC by May 26, 2014. Mr. D. Molteni has been advised of this request and provided with the name and address of the NRC lead inspector assigned to this inspection.

This letter contains information collections that are subject to the *Paperwork Reduction Act of 1995* (44 U.S.C. 3501 et seq.). These information collections were approved by the Office of Management and Budget, approval number 3150-0018.
