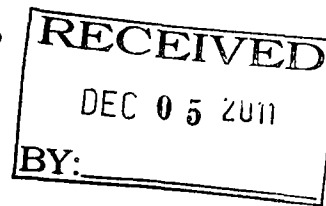

I represent Yokogawa Corporation of America ("YCA") with operations in Newnan, Georgia in their pursuit of registering their beta-ray measurement device through your agency for use by general licensees and obtaining the necessary licenses for selling, importing, distributing, and servicing these devices in the United States. My client has asked that I contact you for the purpose of arranging a meeting concerning the delays in issuance of the SS&D certificate for their beta-ray device and obtaining the aforementioned licenses.

We had submitted what we believe is a complete and comprehensive application in support of the SS&D evaluation and registration along with the applicable fees in person to Eric Jameson at your offices on November 5, 2010. The application for the licenses and applicable fees were mailed to your agency sometime late Spring of this year.

YCA is quite concerned with the delays in the review and processing of these applications. Without the necessary regulatory approvals, my client is finding it quite difficult to market this device to potential customers in the United States and to build a business around this device.


