

RIS 2014-07 Vendor Information Request

- The NRC's vendor inspection program performs inspections at contractor and vendor facilities to examine whether the vendor has been complying with Appendix B to Title 10, Part 50, of the Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR Part 50), as required by procurement contracts with licensees.
- There are multiple methods currently used to collect information for interfaces with vendors and coordinate vendor inspections; however, these methods may not fully capture the number and variety of contractors and vendors supplying basic components and safety-related services.

- <u>What this is</u>
 - Voluntary
 - An opportunity to help populate an internal NRC vendor database to:
 - Facilitate improved communication
 - Plan inspection and allocate resources to vendors
- What this is not
 - A requirement
 - A guaranteed inspection for the vendor / contractors that are provided as a response to the RIS
