Dear Mr. Blair:

Enclosed are the remaining records of Region II Office of Investigation (OI) file 2-2012-023 that are responsive to your FOIA Request, FOIA-2013-0203. These records have been processed pursuant to the discussion between you and Mark Graff in an effort to provide for the immediate release of the records to you.

In the discussion it was explained that since Mr. Hicks, the alleged, agreed to be considered a "widely known alleged" for all of his allegations following the processing of the majority of the enclosed records. As such, additional non-exempt information can be released under the FOIA as compared to the originally-processed version. Mr. Graff indicated that the NRC was willing to re-process the records under this widely-known status which would take additional time to complete the revisions in processing the records.

You indicated that you would prefer that the NRC complete a sampling of the records under the widely-known status, approximately 150 pages, so that you could see the difference in the treatment of Mr. Hicks' identity and the allegations contained within the records. You acknowledged that you would accept the remainder of the records as previously processed, which maintain the privacy of Mr. Hicks as not a widely-known alleged. You indicated you would prefer this option so as to receive the documents sooner.

We also agreed that you would retain the ability to ask, in a separate FOIA request, for the records to be re-processed under the widely-known standard. We also agreed that if you choose to file an additional request, no search fees would be necessary for the records that the NRC has already located pursuant to the present request. We indicated that this would likely allow for the release of the responsive records this week.

As discussed, we are closing your current request with the disclosure of these records as processed, and you are waiving your right to the administrative appeal of the exemptions as applied. However, should you wish to receive these records processed less restrictively under the widely-known standard, you may make a new FOIA request.
