Dear Administrative Judges:

On May 23, 2014, the Board issued a revised general schedule for this proceeding directing that mandatory disclosure updates for any admitted new or amended contentions be completed by May 30, 2014.

In its May 23, 2014 Memorandum and Order (Ruling on Motion to Migrate/Amend Existing Contentions and Admit New Contentions Regarding Final Supplement to Generic Environmental Impact Statement), the Board granted Joint Intervenors' request to migrate Contentions 1 and 3 and amend Contention 2, and denied their request to resubmit Contention 4/5 and admit two new contentions. Because the Board did not admit new contentions in its May 23 Order, and because all disclosures relevant to the matters at issue in amended Contention 2 have already been disclosed in the Staff's monthly hearing file updates, the Staff hereby notifies the Board that it has not identified any necessary updates to its mandatory disclosures at this time.
