SUBJECT: REVIEW OF SUBMITTAL OF REQUESTED STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES REQUIRED BY LICENSE CONDITON 9.8 & 9.12, URANIUM ONE USA, INC., MATERIALS LICENSE SUA-1341, WILLOW CREEK IN SITU RECOVERY PROJECT, CAMPBELL AND JOHNSON COUNTIES, WYOMING (TAC J00707)

Dear Mr. Schierman:

By letter dated June 5, 2013, Uranium One USA, Inc., (Uranium One) submitted a letter and supporting documentation to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in response to requirements in Materials License SUA-1341, License Conditions (LC) 9.8 and 9.12, for the Willow Creek In-Situ Recovery Project in Campbell and Johnson Counties, Wyoming. The NRC staff has completed its review of the information submitted and finds the submission incomplete. Specific reasons that the submission is deemed incomplete were discussed at length during the public meeting on May 27, 2014, held with Uranium One and NRC staff on Willow Creek licensing issues. A meeting summary will be completed by July 9, 2014, and will be sent to Uranium One and will be available in NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS). Based on the details provided in the public meeting, staff is not providing additional details in this letter.

Please note that license SUA-1341 does not require submission of standard operating procedures for LC 9.8. The license states in LC 9.8, paragraph 4, in part, "The licensee shall receive written verification of the licensee's contamination control program prior to its implementation." The license states in LC 9.8, paragraph 5, in part, "The licensee shall receive written verification of the licensees qualified designee(s) training program prior to its implementation."

The NRC staff requests Uranium One submit the information required by LC 9.8 and 9.12 to the NRC within 60 days of the date of this letter.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of ADAMS. ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
