It appears that the copy of our final rule changes for R313-38-3 that was submitted with our letter dated May 1, 2014 was not the final rule. We apologize for this error and inconvenience.

The attached document is the final version and reflects all but one of the rule changes requested by the NRC in your letter dated December 23, 2013. The remaining rule change addresses comment number 2 by correcting the reference currently found in R313-15-1208. We anticipate making this rule change through the Utah Radiation Control Board in the near future.

Please replace the previous copy of R313-38-3 with the attached copy. The final changes reflected in the attached document became effective on April 7, 2014. I have included a copy of the pertinent pages of the *Utah Bulletin*, Utah's analogue to the *Federal Register*, and highlighted in yellow, the information documenting the effective date for the changes to R313-38-3.
