Dear Colleen:

Thank you for taking the time on Thursday, May 29, 2014 to review my amendment submission.


As I explained on Thursday, the walk-way between area (A) and (A2) and the walk-way between area (B) and (B2) were cut out (removed) on approximately 3/26/2014. When accessing the back side of the wall it was discovered that there was termite damage. The wall area(s) that were cut out were surveyed prior and wipe tested prior on 3/25/2014 to assure that there was no radiation and no removable contamination.

The survey/wipe test sheet dated 3/25/2014 was previously submitted on 3/25/2014. The area was again re-surveyed after removal on 3/26/2014 and found to be background as previously surveyed. The removed wall was saved and will not be trashed until we receive NRC amendment approval. Please note that these walls were never contaminated with any form of radioactive material and were only saved as a precautionary measure.

After immediate removal of the damaged wall a solid plywood wall was installed over the walkways from the back-side to prevent any access into the new space. These barriers will remain in place until we receive NRC amendment approval.

Please let me know when the space is approved for use by email. I will then discard the "saved old wall material" and will "remove the barriers". Thank you for all your help in this matter.
