Dear Mr. Parker:

Per our telephone conversation of April 24, 2014, along with subsequent e-mail correspondence, a request was made to change the Authorized Use of the Cs-137 sealed Amersham Model 773 calibration source utilized at this location of use, to more adequately define the scope of use and practice.

The current license condition states:

*Authorized Use (9G): "For use in an Amersham Model 773 calibration device for calibration of instruments, including commercial calibration service for any person as defined in 10CFR30, Section 30.4."*

Please change the existing license condition to the following statement:

*Authorized Use (9G): "For use in an Amersham Model 773 calibration device for calibration of instruments used at facilities covered by this license."*

St. Vincent supports this amendment request which allows Edward E. Wroblewski, MA, d/b/a *Photon Measurements Plus* to utilize this source at this location for commercial use.
