The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has completed the review of AREVA NP, Inc. Richland Facility Emergency Plan (EP) Revision 10.0 dated February 27, 2014. The NRC staff determined that the EP was properly submitted under the provisions of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 70.32(i) and the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the EP. Accordingly, the changes to your EP are acceptable.

This review was assigned Technical Assignment Control (TAC) L33322. Upon approval of the revised EP and issuance of this letter, TAC L33322 is closed.
