Good morning John.

In response to the tasking on the above-referenced FOIA request, in a May 12<sup>th</sup> email, you advised me that I should check with Susie Hicks, ADAMS Support, who would be in possession (if anyone would) of the email authorization from the division director to withdraw the SUNSI-slide from public ADAMS. I have checked with her and she has given me what she has.

However, I would appreciate it if you would review the email string here, as I am trying to "close the loop" on any external communications between NRC personnel and Duke Energy respecting the SUNSI nature of the one slide, which triggered the actions the requester is asking about. According to Robert Pascarelli, the revised slides were provided to you; what he didn't know is whether there was any cover letter or other writing that reflected the exchange between NRC and Duke Energy. If so, that documentation would be responsive.

Margo,

I spoke with Chris Nolan (Corporate Regulatory Affairs manager for Duke Energy) after the public meeting in question. Duke had previously requested that this particular information (drawing of the Jocassi dam) be withheld as OOU-SRI. I had informed Mr. Nolan that their slide package provided at the public meeting had included this drawing and asked him if it did indeed contain OOU-SRI. He called me back a few days later and responded that it did contain OOU-SRI and stated that he would send in a revised set of slides with slide 18 removed so that it could be profiled as publically available in ADAMS. Therefore, the only records that I have is the email that Mr. Criscione referenced in his FOIA request. John Boska (the Oconee PM at the time) had received the revised slides. I don't know if any cover letter (or email) may have been attached with Duke's submittal. Please let me know if you have any further questions.

Bob – sorry to be emailing you piecemeal. In rereading his request letter, he also notes that, based on one of the emails he received in response to last year's virtually identical FOIA request, your email states that "someone from Duke Energy informed the NRC that one of the slides contained SUNSI information" and that it what triggered the change in its ADAMS sensitivity. He didn't receive any documentation about that Duke Energy contact.

Now – it could be that the Duke Energy contact was telephonic, or in person, and not documented anywhere, and that's why he received nothing about that. I would presume that if such a document was received, under record retention schedules, it would still remain with NRC only a year later. Even though it was your email, perhaps the contact wasn't with you. Do you have any recollection of this event and how it happened? Again, I'm trying to close the loose ends about the lack of responsive records and whether the search we are conducting now is "reasonably calculated to locate responsive records." Are there other persons knowledgeable about this contact? I'd like to make sure we're including them in this search.

to non-public. In that email Susie advised that you'd need an office director, or properly delegated official's authorization and justification for that.

He claims not to have received (1) the OD authorization/justification (whether in hard copy or an email) and (2) if it was provided by an OD delegate, a copy of the delegation to that official.

I'd just like to confirm that you do not have these items and, Tracy, if someone else within NRR might, can we be sure to look for them?
