**PUBLIC MEETING** 

Draft regulatory guide (DG)-1141 is proposed revision 4 of regulatory guide (RG) 1.105, "Setpoints for Safety-Related Instrumentation." The International Society of Automation (ISA) is meeting on June 6, 2014 and the lead technical author for the DG, Paul Rebstock, has requested that DG-1141 be released to the public before the meeting so it can be discussed at the meeting. The purpose of this memorandum is to make an early version of DG-1141, "Setpoints for Safety-Related Instrumentation" a publicly available draft document.
