**Re: Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station Renewal, Ottawa County, Ohio**

This is in response to correspondence, received on March 10, 2014 regarding the renewal of the operating license for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station in Ottawa County, Ohio. My comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, and the associated regulations at 36 CFR Part 800.

Based on the information included in your submission, the proposed license renewal, as the only action being reviewed, does not appear to have a high probability effecting historic properties. It is my opinion that the proposed license renewal will not affect historic properties.

No further coordination with this office is necessary unless there is a change in the project. Additionally, any future improvements or earthmoving activities at the Davis-Besse facility requiring review under the regulations at 36 CFR 800 will need to be coordinated with this office. If new or additional historic properties are discovered during implementation of this project, this office should be notified as required by 36 CFR 800.13.
