Mr. Baratta,

This message is regarding your amendment request letter dated April 15, 2014. In order for us to complete our review of your license amendment, we need the following additional information:

1. Please review your decommissioning funding plan (DFP) and determine whether or not the addition of unsealed materials requested at the Denver location, will not affect the decommissioning funding allocation of \$24,000 in your letter of intent dated December 12, 2008, or provide an updated DFP that includes the unsealed material requested at the Denver location stating the revised amount and how it was calculated. Please note that an updated DFP would only be required for the Denver location as an amendment to the current DFP.
2. Your request included cesium-137 in "solid" form. Please clarify that this is a sealed source and include the source manufacturer and model number(s).

You may respond in the form of a letter, signed by yourself, and fax it to our office; or e-mail your response as an attachment (must be a signed copy, scanned into single document). Please include the Mail Control No. 583771 to avoid any processing delays.
