Dear Mr. Burrows:

This letter addresses License Condition 12.23. As discussed with you June 16, 2014, Powertech's plans for the period from July 2014 to July 2015, the initial year under License SUA-1600, do not include production operations with the injection of lixiviant. Rather, Powertech will only undertake construction activities for the period July 2014 to July 2015, with production operations to occur and be accounted for in the subsequent financial assurance period and estimated for July 2015 to July 2016. Powertech hereby requests that the requirements contained in License Condition 12.23 be submitted concurrent with the submittal of the next financial assurance update in July of 2015.

As required by License Condition 9.5, Powertech will submit at least 90 days of the license issuance a revised restoration action plan and updated financial assurance estimate which include an estimate of surface reclamation of construction activities during the period July 2014 to July 2015.

We look forward to hearing from you at your earliest convenience should you need further explanation in this regard.
