Dear Sir:

The purpose of this letter is to request information pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. section 552. If the information is not available from your agency, please forward this request to the appropriate agency or advise me of other agencies which might have this information.

Please provide me with a copy of the following items regarding the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station, Unit No. 1, and Unit NO. 2, located in Scriba, New York. This power plant is in Region 1, for NRC. The relevant time period for this inquiry is January 1, 1968 to January 1, 1988.

1. Any and all documents, including but not limited to correspondence memoranda, facsimiles, electronic transmissions, telephone messages, CDs, computer stored information, microfiche, etc., concerning, relating to, or mentioning asbestos-containing materials and/ or equipment manufactured, sold or distributed to the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station, which were used, installed, replaced, repaired, and/ or maintained at or on behalf of the premises.
2. Any and all documents, including but not limited to Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation purchase orders, invoices, sales agreements, sales receipts, product information or product brochures, relating to asbestos, asbestos-containing products, or asbestos-containing equipment purchased for use at Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station premises.
3. Any and all documents that identify the serial numbers or model numbers of any pump packing or valve packing material used at the premises during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
4. Any and all documents that identify the brand name or manufacturer of any pump packing or valve packing material used at the premises during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
5. Any and all documents that identify the serial numbers or model numbers of any pump gasket or valve gasket material used at the premises during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
6. Any and all documents that identify the brand name or manufacturer of any pump gasket or valve gasket material used at the premises during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
7. Any and all documents, including but not limited to vendor lists for sales of valves, pumps and associated consumables (e.g., packings and gaskets) during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
8. Any and all documents, including but not limited to correspondence, memoranda, facsimiles, electronic transmissions, telephone messages, CDs, computer-stored

- information, microfiche ,etc., concerning, relating to, or referencing Quality Assurance Guidelines at Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station during the relevant time period.
9. Any and all documents, including but not limited to warnings, labels, brochures ,pamphlets, material safety data sheets, product information, or other document, however designated, that accompanied any asbestos, asbestos-containing products, or asbestos obtaining equipment when shipped or delivered to the premises during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Generating Station.
 10. All writings or documents, including but not limited to indices, data compilations, spreadsheets, proprietary information, and/ or computer or metadata, pertaining to any and all inventory of asbestos containing materials, products, or equipment, known or presumed, used at the premises during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
 11. All writings or documents pertaining to the construction, maintenance ,rebuilding, repair/ remodeling work and/ or abatement work performed on the premises, which in any way involved asbestos, asbestos- containing products, or asbestos- containing equipment prior to and/ or during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
 12. All writings identifying any and all persons, contractors or other entities who performed construction, maintenance, rebuilding, repair/ remodeling, and/ or abatement work on the premises, which in any way involved asbestos, asbestos-containing products, or asbestos-containing equipment prior to and/ or during the relevant time period for use at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
 13. All documents regarding the results of research, air quality investigations, and air testing, including any reports and/ or study data from air tests or air sampling made of any asbestos containing products and/ or asbestos containing equipment, which would attempt to measure the amount of asbestos fiber either in the ambient air and/ or released when asbestos, asbestos-containing products, or asbestos-containing equipment was/ were used, machined, operated or otherwise disturbed on the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
 14. All documents, including but not limited to reports, studies, and/ or secondary research, provided to you, which addressed the issue of health hazards created by or associated with the exposure to airborne asbestos fibers and asbestos dust generally or from asbestos containing products and/ or asbestos containing equipment at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
 15. All documents, including but not limited to warnings , directives, instructions or other similar statements regarding asbestos, asbestos-containing products, or asbestos-containing products, or asbestos-containing equipment, issued to you, by any manufacturer, supplier or distributor of asbestos, asbestos-containing products, or asbestos-containing equipment at the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.
 16. All multimedia, including but not limited to digital media, VHS videos, tapes, video cassettes, movie presentations, slide shows, power point presentations, and/ or other forms of presentation whether visual or auditory, that was presented on the issues of health, safety, exposure, dangers, asbestos, and/ or otherwise, that were shown, distributed, supplied for viewing, or used on the premises, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station during the relevant time period.
 17. All writings, documents, memorandum, contracts, purchase orders and sales receipts pertaining to the maintenance, rebuilding, repair/ remodeling work for the recirculation loop failure of March 1982 at Unit 1, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station.

18. All writings, documents, memorandum, contracts, purchase orders and sales receipts pertaining to the construction, maintenance, rebuilding, repair/ remodeling work during periodic outages at Unit 1, Nine Mile Point Nuclear Generating Station from January 1, 1981 to December 31, 1987.
19. All documents and writings pertaining to radiation levels of Unit 1, 50-220 and all adjacent areas from January 1, 1980 to December 31, 1987.
20. All documents and writings pertaining to radiation levels of Unit 2, 50-410 and all adjacent areas from January 1, 1985 to December 31, 1987.
21. All documents and writings pertaining to radiation levels, REMs, etc., of Unit 1, 50-220 staff, including, but not limited to decedent, (b)(6) [REDACTED], from January 1, 1980 to December 31, 1987.

If any part or all of the materials are withheld under an FOIA exemption, please provide a list and mark any deleted sections. Please list the specific exemptions that form the basis for any deletion from a document or the complete withholding of a document.

I request that you furnish the information without any charge or at a reduced charge because the information will be used in a civil lawsuit. Since I am requesting information for this purpose, any fee associated with the search of requested information should be limited to the reasonable standard charges of duplication only. In any event, please provide me with an itemized statement of applicable fees.
