Dear Mr. Goorevich:

Enclosed is an application (XSOU8780/06), dated June 5, 2014, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from AREVA Inc., requesting Amendment No. 6 to its existing license, XSOU8780/05. The license presently authorizes the export of 11,000,000 kilograms of natural uranium, in the form of uranium hexafluoride to various EURATOM countries for enrichment and ultimate use in nuclear power reactors or return to the United States for use in domestic nuclear power plants.

The purpose of the amendment is to: 1) change the name and address of the licensee, 2) add an entity in France to the list of 'Ultimate Consignee(s) in Foreign Country(ies)', 3) remove one of the 'Other Party(ies) to Export' listed on the license, and 4) extend the expiration date from August 31, 2015 to August 31, 2020. There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested; therefore, our office is processing this as minor amendment. The NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
