This refers to the inspection conducted by J. R. Wray of this office on September 4, 1980 of activities authorized by NRC Operating License Nos. DPR-71, DPR-62 and DPR-23 for the Harris Energy and Environmental Center facility, and to the discussion of our findings held with B. H. Webster at the conclusion of the inspection.
